

Before You Leave...	
Perform Tawaf Al-Wadā'	a. Commonly misunderstood, Tawaf al-Wadā' cannot be done whenever. It should be done prior to departure. You cannot perform it and then leave the next day, for in such a case it would not be considered a farewell. Perform it and then leave Makkah without delay.
	b. Women in their menses may leave without performing Tawāf al-Wadā'.
	c. Non can leave until they have performed Tawaf Az-Ziyārah (See 8 *), and that includes women in their menses. The second stage of coming out of Ihram shall remain until you perform it.

## The Days of Hajj

There is no day better in the sight of Allah than the day of Arafah

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Day One	8th	Yomn Al-Tarwiyah (The Day of Watering)
1. Prepare for Ihram	a.	Shower, save underarms and pubic hair, and put on perfume before wearing the White towels. Say: Labbayk Allāhumma Hajjan <i>I am here at Your service, O Allah, to perform Hajj.</i>
	a.	
2. Make a Vocal Intention for Ihram and begin.	b.	In Ihram: the following restrictions apply: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Do not trim any hair.</li> <li>2. Do not cut your nails.</li> <li>3. Do not wear perfume or use something that has perfume in it.</li> <li>4. Do not wear gloves.</li> <li>5. Do not touch the opposite gender with desire.</li> <li>6. Do not consummate a marriage contract.</li> <li>7. Do not perform Intercourse.</li> <li>8. Do not kill any wild animals.</li> </ol> <u>Specific for Men:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do not cover your head, not even with your Ihram towel.</li> <li>• Do not wear clothes that are sewn to the shape of the body, including underwear.</li> <li>• Do not wear shoes, wear sandals instead.</li> </ul> <u>Specific for Women:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do not cover your face. However, I the presence of men you may cover your face as the Mother of Believers, Aish'—may Allāh be pleased with her— did in her Hajj.</li> </ul>
	c.	Note: If there is a chance the you will not be able to complete your Hajj, then say at the time of making intention:  <b>In Habasani Hābis</b> <b>Fa Mahallī Haythu Habastani</b> <i>If any thing holds me back, then my place is where You have held me.</i> Doing so will absolve you of any penalty if you are not capable of completing.
3. Go to Mina	a.	Pray in Mina the following five Salāh at their proper time: Dhuhir, Asr, Maghrib, Isah, Fajr.
	b.	Pray Dhuhir, Asr, and Isha: 2 Rak'at only.
	c.	Spend the night in Mina
	d.	Remember to do Talbiyah (Labbayk Allāhumma Labbayk...) constantly.

Day Two		9th	Yomn Arafah (The Day of Arafah)
4. In the morning, proceed to Arafah	a.	Arafah begins after Dhuhur. Try not to stress yourself with worship in the morning at the expense of the afternoon.	
	b.	After listening to the Khutbah, pray Dhuhur and Asr together (2-2) at Dhuhur time.	
	c.	Pray and remembeer Allah immensely on this day. Arafah is the essence of Hajj.	
	d.	Remain in Arafah until sunset.	
	e.	Delay your Maghrib/Isha – which you shall pray together -- until you reach Muzdalifah.	
5. At sunset, proceed to Muzdalifah	a.	The Islamic day ends at Maghrib, not 12:00 a.m. Like we may be accustomed to in North America. Please keep this in mind.	
	a.	If the bus is taking long, do not delay your prayer past half the night. If it is nearing half the night, pray wherever you are on the road.	
6. Pray Mahrib/Isha in Muzdalifah.	a.	The Prophet prayed Fajr in Muzdalifah, then he stood and supplicated before moving on.	
	b.	In an authentic Haddith, the Prophet gave permission for the elderly and women to leave halfway through the night.	
7. Spend the night in Muzdalifah.	10th		Yomn Ah-Nah (Sacrifice)
	*	Today, you shall do the following: 1. Stone the Agabah Jamarat—the largest Jamarat – with seven pebbles. 2. Slaughter your sacrificial animal – Ifrad Hajji is exempt. 3. Shave or trim your hari. Shaving is preferable. 4. Go to the Ka'bah and perform Tawaf az-Ziyarah. 5. Go to Safa/Marwa and perfm Sai'. This is for the Tamatti' Hajj (And others who may have missed their Sai' when the first came)	
8. After Fajr, Proceed to Mina.	b.	Coming out of Ihram has two stages: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>After you've compiled (*1-3) you come out of Ihram in the first stage. Meaning, everything that was before forbidden is now permissible, except intercourse.</li> <li>After you have completed (*4) everything that was forbidden in Ihram is now permissible. You may delay (*4) to day four or five or six.</li> </ul>	
	c.	At Maghrib the next day begins.	
	d.	Return to Mina to spend the night there.	

Day Four		11th	Ayyām At-Tashriq
9. Spend the night in Mina	a.	You must spend the night in Mina.	
	b.	Do not throw before Dhuhur.	
		Although the time beings at Dhuhur, it is safer to delay the stoning until after Asr or even until night when the crowd lightens up.	
	c.	Say 'Allāhu Akbar' with each individual throw.	
	d.	If possible, make duā after the small and medium Jamarāt.	
	e.	Note: During the Tashriq days, you should pray each Salat at it's proper time. However, Dhuhur/Asr and Isha' should be prayed 2 rakāt only	
f.	In the Qur'an: And remember Allāh during the appointed Days (i.e. Ayyām At-Tashriq). Anyone who hastens to leave in two days, there is no sin on him and whosoever stays on, there is no sin on him, if his aim is to do good. And obey Allāh (fear Him) and know that you will surely be gathered unto Him 2:203		
Day Five		12th	Ayyām At-Tashriq (Cont)
11. Spend the night in Mina	a.	You must spend the night in Mina.	
	a.	Do not throw before Dhuhur.	
	b.	Although the time beings at Dhuhur, it is safer to delay the stoning until after Asr or even until night when the crowd lightens up.	
	c.	Say 'Allāhu Akbar' with each individual throw.	
	d.	If possible, make duā after the small and medium Jamarāt.	
	e.	At Maghrib the next day begins. You must leave Mina before Maghrib if you do not wish to stay for the following day. Although Day Six is originally optional, if you delay your departure you <i>must</i> stay.	
f.	(If you choose not to stay for Day Six): You have now completed Hajj minus Tawāf Al-Wadā (the Farewell Tawāf).		
Day Six		13th	Ayyām At-Tashriq (Optional)
13. Spend the night in Mina	a.	You must spend the night in Mina.	
	a.	Do not throw before Dhuhur.	
	b.	Say 'Allāhu Akbar' with each individual throw.	
	c.	If possible, make duā after the small and medium Jamarāt.	
d.	You have now completed Hajj minus Tawāf Al-Wadā (the Farewell Tawāf).		
14. Beginning from Dhuhur time, stone the three Jamarāt: (Small – Medium – Large)
